

## Beginner, Intermediate, and Advanced Independent Study Fused Glass

We only use Bullseye 90 COE (coefficient of expansion) glass in our glass studio; all glass supplies must be purchased through the AMFA Museum Store. The minimum you can expect to spend during this class is \$85.00 for materials. The cost depends on the scale of the projects you are working on during this class session.
